
URGENT FOR ALL NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBES

RATTLE SNAKE EEFIGY A NATIVE AMERICAN SPIRITUAL SITE This Effigy mound is extremely rare. Found in St. Croix Valley, Afton is located on a vacated native village site that also qualifies as a spiritual site due to the nature of the effigy mound.

To native people who constructed the mounds, they were representation of eternal life.
