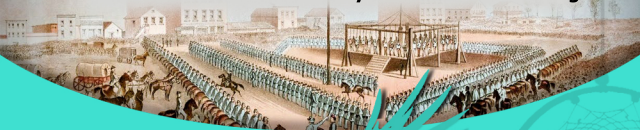

Please bring Tobacco and Sage for the ceremony (if possible).

The ceremony is outdoors—dress warmly as it will be cold.
